Barbara Jean Finnegan, 64 years, of Peebles, Ohio, passed away on Thursday, March 9, 2017, at the Hospice of Hope Ohio Valley Inpatient Center, in Seaman, Ohio.

She graduated from high school in New York and attended Akron University.
