July 19, 1923 - April 26, 2019

Celeste K Brown, 95 years, of Hillsboro, formerly of Peebles, passed away on Friday, April 26, 2019, at the Laurels of Hillsboro Nursing and Rehabilitation Center, in Hillsboro, Ohio.

Celeste was born on July 19, 1923, in Dayton, Ohio, the daughter of the late Raymond and Myrtle (Johnson) Buschwoller. Celeste spent her life caring for family and home, as well as helping to run the family farm.
