Dan Fristoe, 83 years of age, of Peebles, Ohio, passed away on Sunday, September 1, 2024, at Good Samaritan Hospital.

Dan was born on August 6, 1941, in Peebles, Ohio, to the late Richard and Bess (Stewart) Fristoe. Dan spent his life working on the family farm. He attended the Peebles Baptist Church, and he was a member of the Gideons International, Peebles Young Farmers and the Adams County Regional Water District. Dan was the president of the Southern Ohio Feeder Calf Association and former Sunday school teacher.
