Donald A Wilson, 85 years, of Peebles, Ohio, passed away on Monday, February 18, 2019, at his residence.

Donald was born in Highland County, Ohio, on May 2, 1933, the son of the late Estel and Inez (Whitley) Wilson. Donald worked as both a farmer and a realtor.
