



## Edward F. Storer

February 15, 1937 - March 28, 2017

Edward "Ed" F. Storer, 80 years, of Peebles, passed away on Tuesday, March 28, 2017, at his residence, in Peebles, Ohio.

Ed was born in Cincinnati, Ohio, on February 15, 1937, the son of the late William Storer and Unia Stamper Storer. Ed served his country in the United States Air force, during the Vietnam conflict. He was a retired school bus driver and mechanic for the Ohio Valley School District; he had also served as a trustee for Oliver Township.

In addition to his parents, Ed was preceded in death by his two sisters, Ellen Matthews and Gladys Rudisell. He is survived by his wife, Maria Fea Storer, whom he married on December 30, 1973; five sons, Brian Storer, of Wilmington, Ohio; Gary Storer, of Peebles; Dan (Rebecca) Storer, of Circleville; Ron (Kaliko) Storer, of Maui, Hawaii; Troy (Stephanie) Storer, of Louisville, Kentucky. He is also survived by two daughters, Lolita (Charles) Wells, of Wilmington, Ohio; and Simativa (Tavita) Suani, of Oakland, California. Ed also leaves behind sixteen grandchildren and three great-grandchildren.

A Mass of Christian Burial will be held at 11:00 AM, Tuesday, April 4, 2017, at the St. Mary Queen of Heaven Holy Catholic Church, in Peebles, with burial to follow in the Freeland Hollow Cemetery, with Frs. Jason Bedel and Ted Kosse officiating. Military rites will be provided by the Adams County Honor Guard.
