



## Elwood DeBord

September 29, 1922 - December 12, 2020

Elwood DeBord, 98 years, of West Union, Ohio, passed away on Saturday, December 12, 2020, at the Monarch Meadows Nursing and Rehabilitation Center, in Seaman, Ohio.

Elwood was born in Elliott, Kentucky, on September 29, 1922, the son of the late Joseph and Julie (Sloan) DeBord. After serving the in United States Army during World War II, Elwood worked as a farmer, until his retirement. He was a member of the Seaman VFW.
