



## George Puckett

February 28, 1932 - April 23, 2019

George "Pete" Puckett, 87 years, of Peebles, Ohio, passed away on Tuesday, April 23, 2019, at his residence.

Pete was born in Pike County, Ohio, on February 28, 1932, the son of the late George and Dollie (Egles) Puckett. After serving in the United States Army during the Korean War, Pete worked as a Mail carrier for the United States Postal Service. Pete was a member of the American Legion.

In addition to his parents, Pete was preceded in death by five brothers and five sisters. He is survived by his wife Betty (Ryan) Puckett, whom he married on March 13, 1954. Pete also leaves behind two sons, Rick (Shelley) Puckett and Rob (Podie) Puckett, both of Peebles; and a brother, Jack Puckett, of Sinking Spring.
