Glenna (Roush) Grooms, 79 years, of Peebles, Ohio, passed away Saturday, April 18, 2020, at the Brookdale Lakeview Crossing Assisted Living Center, Groveport, Ohio.

Glenna was born in West Union, Ohio, on July 14, 1940, the daughter of the late Ralph and Hazel (Hafer) Roush.
