December 15, 1919 - September 9, 2022

Harlan Frank Plummer, 102 years of age, of Peebles, Ohio, passed away Friday, September 9, 2022, at the Anthology of Mason Assisted Living Facility, in Mason, Ohio.

Harlan was born on December 15, 1919, in Cincinnati, Ohio, the son of the late Walter and Jessie Plummer. Harlan was a retired military veteran, with the distinction of serving in World War II, Korea, and Vietnam. He belonged to the Veterans of Foreign Wars, the Disabled American Veterans, the American Legion Peebles Post #594, and the Masonic Lodge of Peebles, Post #581. In addition to his parents, Harlan was preceded in death by his wife, Viola (Carter) Plummer, whom he married on November 14, 1944, and who passed away on February 13, 2008; and by his daughters, Beverly McKenzie and Sandra Finley. He was also preceded in death by his brother, Walter Plummer II, and his sister, Milly Plummer.
