Herman L Skidmore, 95 years of age, of Peebles, Ohio, passed away on Wednesday, December 6, 2023, at the Monarch Meadows Nursing and Rehabilitation Center, in Seaman, Ohio.

Herman was born on May 26, 1928, in Highland County, Ohio, the son of the late Roy and Mary (Wilson) Skidmore. After serving in the United States Army during the Korean conflict, Herman worked as an engine technician for General Electric Aviation at the Peebles location.
