James "Jim" Dennis Fisher, 79 years of age, of Peebles, Ohio, passed away on Wednesday, June 19, 2024, at the Hospice of Hope Ohio Valley Inpatient Center, in Seaman, Ohio.

Jim was born on July 24, 1944, in Peebles, Ohio, the son of the late Orville and Marguerite (Clark) Fisher. After serving in the United States Army during the Vietnam Conflict, Jim retired from his work as a mail carrier. Jim attended the Peebles Church of Christ.
