James Dale Stewart, 86 years of age, of Seaman, Ohio, passed away on Sunday, March 15, 2026, at the Adams County Regional Medical Center, in Seaman, Ohio.

Jim was born on February 17, 1940, in Blanchester, Ohio, the son of the late Frank and Edna (Steele) Stewart. After serving in the United States Air Force, Jim worked as a laboratory technician for DP&L. Jim was a member of the Seaman Community Methodist Church, where he had previously served as the treasurer. He belonged to the Local #175 Utility Workers, of Dayton; as well as the NRA. He was an active 4-H adviser and the founder of the DP&L Retiree Breakfast Association.
