Loretta Porter, 92 years, of Winchester, passed away on Friday, November 16, 2018, at the Monarch Meadows Nursing and Rehabilitation Center, in Seaman, Ohio.

Loretta was born on January 27, 1926, in Stonecoal, West Virginia, the daughter of the late Serpell Rouse Keesee and Ethel Lee (Nunn) Keesee. Loretta, a homemaker, was a member of the Mt. Calvary Presbyterian Church, and the Mt. Calvary Busy Bees. She also belonged to the Winchester American Legion Auxiliary, the Southern Ohio Horseshoe Association, and the Sunset Bowling League.

In addition to her parents, Loretta was preceded in death by her husband, Thomas G. Porter, who passed away on November 2, 1990.
