Mary Lou McClellan, 94, of Seaman, Ohio, passed away on Monday, April 10, 2023, at her residence.

Mary Lou was born on November 6, 1928, in the May Hill Community, near Seaman, Ohio, the daughter of the late Lester and Bessie (Storer) Post.
