Paul Thomas Alexander, 87 years, of Rarden, Ohio, passed away on Tuesday, January 29, 2019, at the Hospice Center at the Southern Ohio Medical Center, in Portsmouth, Ohio.

Paul was born in Rarden, Ohio, on August 28, 1931, the son of the late Earl Alexander and Esta (Taylor) Alexander. Paul retired after 48 years with the Scioto County Engineer's Office. Paul served as a Rarden township trustee for 12 years, and he attended the Rarden Baptist Church.
