Paul C Douglas, 96 years, of the Locust Grove Community of Peebles, Ohio, passed away on Monday, April 1, 2019, at the Monarch Meadows Nursing and Rehabilitation Center.

Paul was born in Peebles, Ohio, on May 20, 1922, the son of the late Harry and Mabel (Tener) Douglas. After serving in the United States Army during World War II, fighting in the Battle of Normandy, Paul returned to Peebles to work as a farmer. Paul attended the Conaway Chapel Church.

Paul was preceded in death by his parents, and by a brother, Tener Douglas. He is survived by his wife Jean (West) Douglas, whom he married on April 30, 1949. Paul is also survived by three sons, Steve (Sandy) Douglas, of Peebles; Dave (Deb) Douglas, of Wellston; and Roger (Debbie) Douglas, of Peebles; and two daughters, Susan (Kenny) Smith, of Piketon; and Carol Ann (Ronnie) Anderson, of Peebles.
