Richard Foster Thatcher, 78 years of age, of Winchester, Ohio, passed away on Tuesday, May 5, 2026, at the Jewish Hospital - Mercy Health, in Cincinnati, Ohio.

Richard was born on July 19, 1947, in Norwood, Ohio, the son of the late Catherine (Jacobs) and Foster Thatcher.
