Robert M Seaman, 66 years, of Peebles, Ohio, passed away on Wednesday, January 9, 2019, at his residence.

Bob was born in Adams County, Ohio, on August 30, 1952, the son of the late Mark and Dorothy (O'Hara) Seaman. Bob served in the United States Army during the Vietnam conflict. He earned a Bachelor's degree at Ohio State University and was employed by the Adams-Brown County Youth Home as a social worker. Bob was a member of the Peebles Lion's Club and the Peebles Chapter of the American Legion, as well as the National Rifle Association.

Bob was preceded in death by his parents and by two brothers, Mark Seaman, Jr., and Jimmy Seaman. He is survived by his daughter, Bobbie Seaman, of Wilmington. Bob also leaves behind two brothers, P.D. Seaman, of Chillicothe; and Dwight Seaman, of Peebles; and a sister, Claudia Ruggles, of Springfield.
