Roger Lee McFarland, 72 years, passed away on Saturday, September 10, 2017, at Brookside Inn in Castle Rock, Colorado.

Roger was born in Peebles, Ohio, on October 22, 1944, the son of the late Harry Earl McFarland and Kathryn Marie (Branham) McFarland.
