



Ronald Pedicord

February 15, 1927 - February 20, 2015

Dr. Ronald Pedicord, age 88 of West Union, passed away Friday, February 20, 2015 at Hospice of Hope Ohio Valley Inpatient Center.

He was born in Battle Creek, Michigan on February 15, 1927 the son of the late Harold C. and Hazel (Norton) Pedicord.

Dr. Ron Pedicord has been chosen to be the Grand Marshal of the West Union Lions Club 4th of July 2014 parade. Dr. Ron practiced in Dayton, Ohio for 25 years and continued to practice in West Union for another 25 years. He served as a Naval Aviation Radioman and gunner in WWII. After attending Miami University in Oxford he graduated with a Doctor of Chiropractic degree from International Chiropractic College. He served on the faculty for 10 years and was head of the physical therapy dept. He later earned his Doctor of Mechanotherapy and Naturopathy degree from Great Lakes College in Cleveland and was a certified Acupuncturist. He served on the Board of Directors of the Ohio State Chiropractic Assoc. for 14 years and was inducted into the Ohio Chiropractic Hall of Fame in 1994. He also served as president of the Academy of Chiropractic Neurology, the Miami Valley Chiropractic Society and the South Central Chiropractic Assoc.

Dr. Ron and his wife, Jan have been married for 67 years and have had 3 children, Dr. Scott Pedicord of Dayton, Ohio, Gayle Ingram of Kettering, Ohio,

and Kathy Pedicord who precedes him; 3 grandchildren, Lori Osterday, Todd Pedicord, and Erin Alexander; 8 great grandchildren; and 1 great-great granddaughter. They have been members of the West Union Presbyterian Church and are now members of the Seaman Presbyterian Church. They have owned 3 farms in Adams County and raised Polled Herford cattle. Also surviving are his brother, Larry and Nancy Pedicord of Florida and several nieces and nephews who saw him as a father figure. In addition to his parents and daughter, also preceding him is one sister, Margaret Blaze.

Dr. Pedicord has been a member of the West Union Lions Club for 36 years and served twice as president. He has been honored with the Melvin Jones Fellowship.

Memorial services will be held on Thursday, February 26, 2015 at 1:00 P.M. at the Seaman Presbyterian Church with Bill Kirby officiating. Gathering of family and friends will be held on Thursday from 11:00 A.M. till 1:00 P.M. at the church. Military Rites will be given by the Adams County Honor Guard. Burial will be held at Dayton Memorial Park at a later date.
