Scott Howard Campbell, 48 years of age, of Rarden, Ohio, passed away Thursday, April 21, 2022, at the Southern Ohio Medical Center, in Portsmouth, Ohio.

Scott was born on July 19, 1973, in Portsmouth, Ohio, the son of Emma (Pertuset) and the late Howard Campbell. He was employed as the Chief Deputy Recorder for the Scioto County Recorder's Office.
