Thomas R. Hughes, 99 years of Seaman, passed away on Friday July 27, 2018 at the Ohio Veterans Home in Georgetown.

He was born in Adams County on November 23, 1918, the son of the late Samuel and Bertha (Mahaffey) Hughes. Besides his parents, he was also preceded by his wife, Charlotte (Bloom) Hughes and 15 brothers and sisters.

Thomas was a member of the Countryside Church of Christ, served in the United States Army during World War II, being a recipient of the Bronze and Silver Star, the Purple Heart and a member of the Ohio Military Hall of Fame, was a member of the Seaman American Legion Post #633, F & AM Lodge #166 and was a member of the Adams County Honor Guard.
