Tom McDonough, 92 years of age, of Peebles, Ohio, passed away on Monday, April 28, 2025, at the Hospice of Hope Ohio Valley Inpatient Center, in Seaman, Ohio.

Tom was born on October 28, 1932, in O'Bryonville, a community in Cincinnati, Ohio, the son of the late Charles and Cecilia (Hart) McDonough. Tom retired from his career serving in the United States Air Force, having served during both the Korean and Vietnam conflicts.

Tom is survived by his son, Mike and Cathy McDonough, of Amelia, Ohio; and his daughter, Cathy and Ed Feltner, of Cincinnati. Tom will be dearly missed by his three grandchildren, Austin, Amy, and Alison.
