Vivian L Jansen, 82 years of age, of Peebles, Ohio, passed away on Saturday, June 19, 2021, at her home.

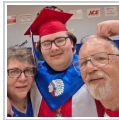

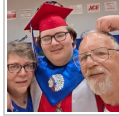

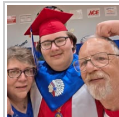
